#### **Green Highway**

## **Research & Publication**

The NTF and Gauhati
University's South East
Asia Studies have jointly
undertaken a project of
rhino poaching and its
markets in SEA. Through
this project, the rhino
poaching track was
investigated and sought
to find out how the rhino
horns are taken out of
Assam and it ends up
where. After a yearlong
research, a book named



Mandalay was published. Through the book the route of the poached rhino horn was traced and found out that most of these horns end up inChina. This is first of such

research and finding were written in a lucid way in the book Mandalay which was inaugurated in Gauhati University.

## **Collaboration with Axom Xahitya Xabha**

The NTF and Axom Xahitya xabha (AX) have come together to launch a new project called Nanda Talukdar Social History Project to document all major happenings of the state and all information in regard of that in a cloud based repository for generations to come.

The Axom Xahitya Xabha and the Nanda Talukdar Foundation(NTF) signed the MoU to launch a social-political history project to document and research cotemporary social political history under the The Nanda Talukdar Social History project.

The project is guided by a three member committee with one representative drawing



from both the organizations and one independent member. The three member committee shall be comprised of Xabha President Dr. Paramanada Rajbongshi, Professor Dr Udayan Mishra and Mrinal Talukdar of the Nanda Talukdar Foundation.

This is a self generating project, which will try to document the Socio-political history of Assam and the North East, specially the post independence era, chronicling the series of events Assam and the region have faced over the decades.

<u>Objectives:</u> Dr Nanda Talukdar was not only an integral part of Axom Xahitya Xabha with various portfolios for three decades but he has been considered a literary giant and this is an attempt belatedly, not only to give recognition to his immense volume of work towards Xabha and literary world but carry forward his research based work as mark of tribute to this great scholar.

<u>How to achieve the objective:</u> Dr Talukdar died in 1983 and his immediate family members gave shape to Nanda Talukdar Foundation(NTF), which has grown over the past two and half decades to an organization of repute specializing in the Contemporary Social History Research, documentation besides 19<sup>th</sup> Century Assamese Literature preservation and digitalization.

The Axom Xahitya Xabha and NTF join hands and give the Contemporary Social History research a definitive and institutionalizing shape.

<u>Modus Operandi:</u> A three member committee with President of AXX and Secretary of NTF and a domain specialist of repute from outside the two organizations shall form an Advisory Committee which will supervise, oversee and mentor the Project.

<u>Day to Day Operation</u>: The day to day operation, leg work for research work, documentation and digitalization or in simple language all the manpower shall be provided by the Nanda Talukdar Foundation form their pool of researchers, done for which the NTF which will seek guidance and mentorship from the Advisory Committee. Resource:

The Project shall seek to generate fund from independent sources as well as self financing publications to maintain and carry forward sustainable research and documentation of the Social History research. The Project, with the mandate from the Advisory Board, shall generate resource for the project as an when need arises. The NTF will bear the administrative cost of the project as well as day to day logistics and funds generated by the project shall be used for research and publication only.
